Certain items can actually contaminate the material collected and make it unusable for recycling. Do not include these items in the tan recycle cart.

- Aerosol Cans
- Styrofoam
- Batteries
- Plastic Bags
- Shredded Paper
- Oil or Paint Cans
- Hazardous Chemicals
- Ceramics
- Crystal
- Glass windows
- Mirrors
- Windshields

Please do not include these items in your tan recycle cart.

Place your tan recycling cart at the curb by 6:00 AM on your pickup day.





City of Medicine Lodge Curbside Single Stream Recycling

It almost always takes less energy to make a product from recycled materials than it does to make it from new materials.

Place your recyclables directly into the recycling cart.

Plastic bags pose a problem at the sorting facility where your recyclables are separated for distribution to end markets. Bags tangle in the machinery and can actually harm the equipment. DO NOT BAG YOUR RECYCLABLES.

Place your tan recycling cart at the curbside by 6:00 AM on your pickup day every other week.

Use the tan recycling cart only for recyclables, NOT for trash.

Place your recycle cart at least 5 feet from your trash cart or other obstacles like a sign or mailbox.

Placing the recycle and trash cart on opposite sides of the driveway works well.





Reduce Reuse Recycle

Recyclables do not need to be sorted.

Collect the recyclables and place them inside the tan recycle cart.

- Glass jars and bottles
- Aluminum and tin cans
- Plastic Recyclable containers type 1-7

Plastic containers that have a recycling symbol 1-7 on the bottom are acceptable. This includes most milk jugs, pop bottles, food and soap bottles. Unmarked plastics and plastic bags are not acceptable. Empty your recyclables and rinse. Labels do not need to be removed. The label on the recycle cart lid also shows what items are acceptable.



DO NOT BAG YOUR RECYCLABLES



- Mixed Paper
 - Newspapers
 - Books
 - Magazines
 - Cardboard
 - School papers
 - Cereal boxes
 - Junk mail

Do not bag or bundle your mixed paper. Simply place it into the recycle cart.

Crush plastic and aluminum cans and cut cardboard to save space.
